The puppy will be relisted for sale and buyer has forfeited their deposit.

This puppy is sold on a NO-BREEDING contract with a PROMISE TO SPAY or NUETER by:

______. PUPPY is not to be used in any illegal or immoral activity. Puppy is to live a indoor pet life, not to be left running at large. If buyer cannot keep puppy, buyer is to return it to breeder and breeder will adopt the puppy out and compensate buyer with the adoption money minus expenses readying puppy for adoption. This puppy is to be kept up to date at vets, BREEDER RECOMENDS ALL VACCINES UNTIL 6 MONTHS INCLUDING RABIES THEN TO "TITER" TEST INSTEAD OF RE VACCINATE AND ONLY VACCINATE WHEN TITER TEST SHOWS LACK OF IMMUNITY. Breeder cannot force this upon buyer. Breeder also recommends microchipping at time of spay.

This puppy has a health certificate clearing her ready for sale as well as vaccine record for first puppy shots. Puppy has been treated 4 times with a full dose of Strongid T wormer and two measured doses by her weight of Advantage and is due for next treatment of wormer and flea preventative with next vaccine which is due by: _____. Buyer must provide proof of spay certificate by: ______at the latest. Puppy has ______ tattooed on ear as a identifier.

We require quarterly updates on your puppy or dog from us, we are ALWAYS here for you if you need us in any way. The StoryBook Pomeranians group has come together for many members to fundraise when needed for emergencies. We ask you always update us on anything that might happen that would cause concern so we can help and so we know if its anything we should check for with the rest of the litter.

We require a good diet, weather grain free (but with added taurine to avoid DCM) or grains. We ask to not feed rawhide anything to your dogs. It is very dangerous. There are a few brands we prefer and encourage for our puppy parents, If at all possible we encourage you to look in to raw. We feed a variety of different things depending on each dogs needs on top of their daily kibble.

We ask that you have your pup in to the vet within 48 hours of getting them from us to ensure all is well between our vet check and yours, it is not forced though as some wait till next round of vaccines. We do not offer a lifetime warranty, once the dog leaves our care we can not control its environment, diet and up bringing. However, if a puppy had something congenital we would take the puppy back and offer a puppy from future litter or refund once our next litter sells.

We require proof of spay or neuter by 9 months of age, we are very firm on our no breeding contracts. If you want to breed you need to be upfront so I can ensure you get a dog fit for breeding weather from me or I point you to another breeder that may better suit what your looking for. If you are caught breeding on a pet contract, we have to right to seize the dog and the puppies and sue for costs of rearing and vetting dogs. If an accident occurs you must report it to us right away. We will rear the litter in our home and place the pups on pet contracts and help you with fixing the dog.



We require a indoor home, not a kennel life. We require a safe home, to not be found running at large. To not be used in dog bait training or puppy mill activity. We require a home free of neglect. If we find the pup in danger or neglected, we will offer a solution to help fix it if you can not correct it we will file for custody. We understand accidents happen, and puppy hood is challenging and in no way do we expect perfection. We will try our hardest to guide you through anything that may arise.

If for any reason you can not keep your puppy we will help you place it, We will reimburse you what we charge for the adoption minus all expenses. Luxating Patella: We are very focused on only breeding dogs with good Patella's, however even two dogs with perfect scores can have pups with lower scores, the one common mistake Pommy owners make is that they let their puppies jump up and down off furniture as well as not providing puppy food until done growing. A puppy should not be on huge excursions or in major agility until after 9 months of age. We encourage anyone unfamiliar with the breed to look up Poms and learn more about this to ensure its something you can handle if it does pop up. *IF* at the 8-week mark when we get vet check and first vaccine we see the patella is not in good grade we reduce the price a bit or offer to take a refund once rest of pups are paid for.

Collapsing Trachea: there isn't really a way to test this in house, but its common in the breed. We ensure none of our breeding dogs have this issue, and we have only one case pop up that we know of and it was due to injury. We recommend never walking on a collar and always using an appropriate harness. We can help you shop for the right one if needed. Also watching what they eat and avoiding choking hazards helps. This normally waits till the dog is older to present itself but I've heard of it popping up within the first two years as well. If ever diagnosed we would do our best to support you every step of the way.



Hypoglycemia: Poms especially puppies are susceptible to sugar drops, these can happen from stress, exercise or lack of proper food. We encourage you to learn more about this, and learn to see the signs. We strive to prepare you and if we feel a particular puppy is more likely to react (usually the tiny ones are) we provide you with an emergency paste to help combat those moments. If the signs go ignored it can result in seizures, lethargy and even death. Toy breeds are very prone to this and its imperative you are prepared.
